

TERMS OF RECRUITMENT TO THE INTERNATIONAL CLASSES.

PUBLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL NO. 20 IN OPOLE

1. The address of residence does not affect application procedure.
2. The recruitment to the International Classes is based on the standard rules of recruitment to Public Elementary Schools; however, there are additional criteria set forward by the Public Elementary School no. 20.
3. The priority is given to:
 - Children, whose first language is English,
 - Children, who come from bilingual families,
 - Children of foreign investors.
4. We conduct an informal interview with the remaining applicants to ensure that the international class is the right fit for them.
5. The goal of the interview is to check:
 - emotional readiness of a child/applicant
 - school readiness
 - an aptitude for learning a foreign language.
6. The Assessment Committee (teachers and psychologists) add up the score of each student and create a list with the total score of each student.
7. The number of points gathered by a young applicant determines his or her placement in the international class.
8. The remaining terms of recruitment are in compliance with general terms of recruitment.
9. No child will be discriminated against based on race, ethnicity or religion.
